There will be no charge for this information.

Please be aware that EOIR is a component of the **Department of Justice** and the custodian of records for the "Record of Proceedings" (ROP), which is the compilation of documents and digital audio recordings produced in proceedings before the immigration courts and the BIA. The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) is the custodian of records for the "A-file," which is a series of records of a person's immigration history and is maintained and stored by DHS. **EOIR is not the custodian of records for DHS or its components, nor does EOIR have access to DHS's A-files.** EOIR does not create an ROP until matters are initiated by DHS. Nevertheless, EOIR may create and maintain ROPs for proceedings other than removal proceedings (i.e., credible fear reviews, bond hearings). You may request a copy of your Notice to Appear (NTA) and full A-file from [DHS](#).

Note that parties to immigration cases (including respondents and their representatives of record) have the option to request their Record of Proceedings directly from the immigration court or Board of Immigration Appeals. 



NOTICE OF *FRANCO-GONZALEZ* CLASS MEMBERSHIP AND REQUEST FOR
COMPETENCY INQUIRY

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security, U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (“DHS” or “the Department”), hereby notifies the Immigration Court that the respondent—if unrepresented—is a member of the class certified in *Franco-Gonzalez v. Holder*, No. 10-2211, 2011 WL 11705815, 16 (C.D. Cal. 2011), and entitled to certain procedural protections in accordance with the injunction entered by the District Court for the Central District of California.¹ *Franco-Gonzalez v. Holder*, 2014 WL 5475097, 3

¹ On November 21, 2011, the district court certified the following Class and Sub-Classes of unrepresented, detained aliens:

Class: All individuals who are or will be in DHS custody for [immigration] proceedings in California, Arizona, and Washington who have been identified by or to medical personnel, DHS, or an Immigration Judge, as having a serious mental disorder or defect that may render them incompetent to represent themselves in [immigration] proceedings, and who presently lack counsel in their [immigration] proceedings.

Sub-Class 1: Individuals in the above-named Plaintiff Class who have a serious mental disorder or defect that renders them incompetent to represent themselves in [immigration] proceedings.

Sub-Class 2: Individuals in the above-named Plaintiff Class who have been detained for more than six months.

Franco-Gonzales v. Napolitano, 2011 WL 11705815, 16 (C.D. Cal. 2011); *Franco-Gonzalez v. Holder*, 2014 WL 5475097, 12 (C.D. Cal. 2014) (defining “immigration proceedings”). The respondent should be considered a class member if he or she is currently unrepresented or becomes unrepresented during the

(C.D. Cal. 2014) (order further implementing the injunction and, inter alia, setting forth the criteria for class membership); *Franco-Gonzalez v. Holder*, 2013 WL 8115423 (C.D. Cal. 2013) (permanent injunction order); *see also Franco-Gonzalez v. Holder*, 2013 WL 3674492 (C.D. Cal. 2013) (partial summary judgment order).

In this case, a qualified mental health provider determined that the respondent has a serious mental disorder or condition, as defined in the district court's orders. *Franco-Gonzalez v. Holder*, 2014 WL 5475097, 3 (C.D. Cal. 2014). The Department provides the following information and documents² for consideration by the Immigration Court: a Mental Health Review ("IHSC Form 883") and additional mental health documents.

Pursuant to the district court's orders, the Immigration Court must conduct an inquiry regarding the respondent's mental competency within 21 days and, if the respondent is determined not competent to represent him- or herself, arrange for the provision of a Qualified Representative. *Franco-Gonzalez v. Holder*, 2014 WL 5475097, 7 ("The Immigration Judge shall convene a Judicial Competency Inquiry no later than 21 days after receiving the notice ... that a detainee is a member of the Main Class."); *id.* at 8-11 (setting forth the timelines and circumstances under which EOIR shall provide Qualified Representatives); *see generally Matter of M-A-M-*, 25 I&N Dec. 474, 481-82 (BIA 2011) ("If an Immigration Judge determines that a respondent lacks sufficient

course of his or her proceedings. For purposes of the district court's orders, a respondent is considered unrepresented unless one of the following has entered an appearance on their behalf: "(1) an attorney, (2) a law student or law graduate directly supervised by a retained attorney, or (3) an accredited representative, all as defined in 8 C.F.R. § 1292.1." *Franco-Gonzalez*, 2014 WL 5475097, 3 n.8 (quoting *Franco-Gonzalez v. Holder*, 828 F. Supp. 2d 1133, 1147 (C.D. Cal. 2011)).

² The Department will supplement the record as soon as practicable upon receipt of additional relevant information or documents and will also submit any other medical records in ICE's possession, custody, or control should the Immigration Judge request such information.

³ In addition, the respondent has been detained in ICE custody since October 18, 2016. Pursuant to the district court’s orders, the Immigration Court must schedule a bond hearing that “comple[s] with the requirements of *Singh v. Holder*, 638 F.3d 1196 (9th Cir. 2011) ... as soon as is practicable, but no more than 15 days, after [a *Franco* Class member] has been detained for 180 days.” *Franco-Gonzalez v. Holder*, 2013 WL 8115423, 2 (C.D. Cal. 2013). If the respondent has been detained for 180 days at the time he or she is identified as a class member, the district court’s orders require the Immigration Court to schedule the bond hearing within 15 days of identification.

MENTAL HEALTH REVIEW

Current Mental Health History: (Name, gender, symptoms)

Smedema, Hans. Male. The detainee reports that he is asymptomatic and does not appear to be in distress. However, the detainee presents with what is determined as a complex fixed delusion. His thought content is highly improbable and most likely a result of a delusional system. He appears to be highly invested in his delusion. A second opinion by Psychiatry confirmed the diagnosis of Delusional Disorder.

Past Mental Health History: (History of treatment, hospitalizations, drug abuse or treatment)

The detainee reported that in 2000 he received outpatient psychological and psychiatric care. There are no known psychiatric hospitalizations or substance abuse/dependence treatment.

Current Psychiatric Treatment: (Medications, therapy)

The detainee is currently receiving psychiatric services. The detainee declines further mental health support, stating that he does not suffer from mental disease. He declined psycho-pharmacological intervention.

Medical History: (Physical conditions, medications, allergies)

The detainee has been diagnosed with the following medical disorders/conditions: Essential hypertension; mixed hyperlipidemia; gout. He has been prescribed the following medications: Aspirin, Allopurinol, Simvastatin, and and Losartan Potassium. There are no known allergies.

Mental Status:

Appearance: Within normal limits in height, weight, and posture.

Attitude: Cooperative.

Behavior: No evidence of behavioral dysregulation.

Mood and Affect: Mood euthymic and affect appropriate.

Speech: No evidence of aphasia, dysarthria, or non-fluent speech.



BRIEF IN SUPPORT OF CUSTODY REDETERMINATION

COMES NOW the Respondent, Mr. Hans SMEDEMA, through EOIR Contract Qualified Representative Fermin Vargas, Esq., hereby respectfully requests consideration of a redetermination of custody. Respondent is currently detained, and has been in custody since September 30, 2016, pending completion of his asylum proceedings.

LEGAL ARGUMENT

The standard for setting an immigration bond was declared in *Matter of Patel*, 15 I&N Dec. 666 (BIA 1976). An alien generally is not and should not be detained or required to post bond and bond should be granted, except on a finding that he is a threat to the national security, *Carlson v. Landon*, 243 U.S. 524, (1952), or that he is a poor bail risk, *Matter of Andrade*, 19 I&N Dec. 102 (BIA 1967); *Matter of S-Y-L*, 9 I&N Dec. 575 (BIA 1962); *Matter of Patel*, 15 I & N Dec. 666, (BIA 19786); *Matter of Daryoush*, 18 I & N Dec. 352 (BIA 1982). The Immigration Judge may look at a number of factors in determining whether a respondent merits release from custody, as well as the amount of bond that is appropriate. *Matter of Guerra*, 24 I&N Dec. 37, 40 (BIA 2006).

Pursuant to the Board decision in *Matter of Guerra*, some of the factors in assessing whether release is appropriate include: “(1) whether the alien has a fixed address in the United States; (2) the alien’s length of residence in the United States; (3) the alien’s family ties in the United States, and whether they may entitle the alien to reside permanently in the United States in the future; (4) the alien’s employment history; (5) the alien’s record of appearance in court; (6) the alien’s criminal record, including the extensiveness of criminal activity, the recency of such activity, and the seriousness of the offenses; (7) the alien’s history of immigration violations; (8) any attempts by the alien to flee prosecution or otherwise escape from authorities; and (9) the alien’s manner of entry to the United States.” *Matter of Guerra*, 24 I&N Dec. 37, 40 (BIA 2006).

Application of these factors shows the Respondent should be released on bond:

(1) Fixed address in the United States:

If released, Mr. Smedema will reside at La Posada de Guadalupe Shelter in Carlsbad, California. (See **Exhibit B**, Declaration of Hans Smedema). La Posada is a short-term and long-

term housing program for homeless men. (*See Exhibit A*, Information on La Posada Housing Program). They provide a safe and sober environment as well as medical referrals to local health providers. Additionally, they have 12 step AA sessions for the residents. *See Id.* The undersigned attorney has spoken to the program manager at La Posada and has confirmed that Mr. Smedema qualifies for the shelter. The program manager at La Posada stated to the undersigned attorney that they would be able to hold a bed for Mr. Smedema with 24-hour notice of his release date.

As such, Mr. Smedema intends to live at La Posada de Guadalupe Shelter should he be released on bond prior to his master calendar hearing. Given that it is a fixed address where Mr. Smedema can stay, this factor weighs in his favor.

(2) Length of residence in the United States:

Mr. Smedema has applied for asylum in the United States in the past. (*See Exhibit B*, Declaration of Hans Smedema). While it is true that Mr. Smedema has spent a substantial amount of life residing outside of the U.S., he desires to remain in the United States as a refugee. Mr. Smedema has claimed adamantly that he is subject to being persecuted by the Dutch government. *See Id.* Consequently, he fears returning to his home country in the Netherlands. Moreover, La Posada de Guadalupe helps individuals secure affordable housing, all in an effort to promote self-help efforts.

Thus, Mr. Smedema's minimal residence in the U.S. should not impact him very negatively since many asylum applicants, such as himself, usually reside in the United States during the brief period in which their case is being adjudicated.

(3) Mr. Smedema's avenue for potential immigration relief:

Mr. Smedema is seeking asylum in the United States based on persecution from his home country, the Netherlands. Mr. Smedema has a master calendar hearing scheduled for January 26, 2017.

Accordingly, this factor falls in Mr. Smedema's favor in demonstrating that he is possibly entitled to reside in the United States as a matter of law.

(4) Mr. Smedema's record of appearance in court:

It is submitted that Mr. Smedema has been cooperative and willing to appear at all his court proceedings. As such, there is no record that reflects that he is unwilling to appear to any further proceedings, nor is there any record of extensive absences on his behalf.

Accordingly, Mr. Smedema's impeccable attendances at his court proceedings demonstrate that this *Guerra* factor tips in his favor as well.

(5) Mr. Smedema has no criminal record:

It is submitted that Mr. Smedema has no criminal history in the United States. Given the lack of crimes and lack of NTA (Notice to Appear) issued in his case, he would not be a priority for law enforcement according to the DHS November 2014 Johnson Memo¹.

Thus, given the fact that Mr. Smedema has no crimes on his record, this *Guerra* factor weighs in Mr. Smedema's favor.

(6) Lack of attempts by Mr. Smedema to flee prosecution or otherwise escape from authorities:

It is submitted that Mr. Smedema has never been evasive and otherwise a flight risk. To the contrary, he has shown up to all his court proceedings, no matter the unfavorable outcomes.

Thus, this *Guerra* factor weighs in Mr. Smedema's favor.


Conclusion:

In sum, there are various *Guerra* factors that weigh in Mr. Smedema's favor. Mr. Smedema is extremely cooperative and wishes to continue actively pursuing asylum as a form of relief in the United States. Mr. Smedema knows the importance of attending all the court hearings and understands the consequences if he fails to appear at any future hearings.

For the reasons indicated, Mr. Smedema seeks his release from detention on his own recognizance or as an alternative on minimum bond. Should he be released, Mr. Smedema will reside at La Posada de Guadalupe in Carlsbad, California.

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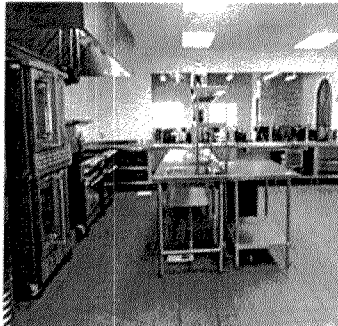

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Honorable Judge McSeveney,

Please accept this as my declaration in support of my upcoming custody determination hearing. I have prepared this declaration with the help of my Qualified Representative. I have approved its contents.

1. My Name is Hans SMEDEMA. I have been in detention since September 30, 2016. I applied for asylum at the San Ysidro Port of Entry at that date. While in detention, I have not been able to reach any family as they are currently residing in Europe.
2. I have previously applied for asylum two times in the past: Once in Miami on April 20, 2009, and also in Texas on November 5th, 2013.
3. I understand that going to my immigration court hearings is important because I want to know how my asylum application is being decided.
4. I fear returning to my home country in the Netherlands because the Dutch Government has continuously failed to prosecute a crime that occurred in my family. Despite my attempts to persuade the government to file charges against those responsible, they have repeatedly failed to do so, in violation of my Dutch constitutional rights.
5. I do not feel safe in the Netherlands, and wish to apply for asylum in the United States.
6. I would like to get out of detention so that I can keep working on my asylum case with my qualified representative. I would also like to get out of detention so that I can continue writing a book which I am working on.
7. If I am released I would stay at a shelter. My attorney has informed me of a place that will take me in. It is a shelter that will give me a stable place to stay and will help me stay in contact with both the court and also with my attorney.
8. If I get out, I am willing to check in with my attorney and ICE while I am at the shelter. This shelter will help me get back on my feet and help me find permanent housing in the event that I am granted asylum and need a permanent place to reside in the U.S.



The U.S. Department of Homeland Security, U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (“DHS” or “the Department”), hereby notifies the Immigration Court that the respondent—if unrepresented—is a member of the class certified in *Franco-Gonzalez v. Holder*, No. 10-2211, 2011 WL 11705815, 16 (C.D. Cal. 2011), and entitled to certain procedural protections in accordance with an injunction entered by the District Court for the Central District of California. *Franco-Gonzalez v. Holder*, 2014 WL 5475097, 3 (C.D. Cal. 2014) (order further implementing the injunction and, inter alia, setting forth the criteria for class membership).

The respondent has been detained in ICE custody since October 18, 2016. Pursuant to the district court’s orders, the Immigration Court must schedule a bond hearing that “comple[s] with the requirements of *Singh v. Holder*, 638 F.3d 1196 (9th Cir. 2011) ... as soon as is practicable, but no more than 15 days, after [a *Franco* class member] has been detained for 180 days.” *Franco-Gonzalez v. Holder*, 2013 WL 8115423, 2 (C.D. Cal. 2013). If the respondent has been detained for 180 days at the time he or she is identified as a Class member, the district court’s orders require the Immigration Court to schedule the bond hearing within 15 days of identification.

MENTAL HEALTH REVIEW

Current Mental Health History: (Name, gender, symptoms)

Smedema, Hans. Male. The detainee reports that he is asymptomatic and does not appear to be in distress. However, the detainee presents with what is determined as a complex fixed delusion. His thought content is highly improbable and most likely a result of a delusional system. He appears to be highly invested in his delusion. A second opinion by Psychiatry confirmed the diagnosis of Delusional Disorder.

Past Mental Health History: (History of treatment, hospitalizations, drug abuse or treatment)

The detainee reported that in 2000 he received outpatient psychological and psychiatric care. There are no known psychiatric hospitalizations or substance abuse/dependence treatment.

Current Psychiatric Treatment: (Medications, therapy)

The detainee is currently receiving psychiatric services. The detainee declines further mental health support, stating that he does not suffer from mental disease. He declined psycho-pharmacological intervention.
