Why are you trying to file? I allowed to file charges, so in the appeal case I tried to do the same. It was down to twelve, but none of the witnesses were allowed. That was the result.

Do you think that the Dutch government has taken such an interest in your case? I think the queen must have made a special ruling not to take up the case. In the special ruling, she would look bad. I am the victim of her signature. I think that the queen took an interest in covering up your case. I told my family and my wife's family asked the queen to make a special ruling and my wife still has it. In the appeal case in 2011 and 2012 we had three judges refused. Six, even because there were three judges against my defense. If you cannot defend yourself, anyone would be deported. I did the Dutch government are working together. So I had to leave the Netherlands for trying to get to America.

Why were you put in jail for trying to get to America? I was deported in 2009 because there was not enough proof. I asked what I had to do to come to American soil and ask for asylum again. So I went to the airport and asked me entry. When they were taking me to the plane to leave, the government was behind it. So I was sent back. I had a return ticket to Paris. So they sent me to Paris and from there I went to the Netherlands. So I went to the American border. A few hours before my flight to Mexico I was deported.
