

ANNEX 5 - Evidence of the 2016 Deceptive Medical Mandate (Confiscated Spanish Document procured by Drs. Janne Geraets, Albir)

RESPONDENT STATE PARTY: The Kingdom of Spain **NATURE OF DOCUMENT:** Confiscated Spanish Legal Document, Covert Audio Evidence (janne.mp3), and Proof of Medical Weaponization **SUBMISSION FOR:** UNCAT Individual Communication

1. Factual Background: The Deceptive Procurement of the Mandate

On January 29, 2016, at the Brew Rock establishment in Albir/Altea, Spain, the complainant was specifically targeted by a Dutch psychologist, Drs. Janne (Johannes) Geraets, who was allegedly operating as an asset for the Dutch Secret Service (AIVD) to orchestrate the complainant's destabilization in exile 1-3.

Under the guise of offering assistance, Geraets lured the complainant into signing an unknown, highly technical legal document written entirely in Spanish 2, 4, 5. The complainant, not being fluent in complex Spanish legal terminology, was misled about the document's true nature 5. Geraets initially provided the complainant with a copy of this signed document, but a few minutes later—allegedly after receiving a phone call from his intelligence handlers—he abruptly confiscated the copy, falsely claiming the document was a "mistake" or unnecessary 2, 4, 5.

Crucially, the complainant possesses an objective covert audio recording (janne.wav / janne.mp3) captured on July 20, 2018, at the 'Anchor' bar in Albir 5-7. In this recording, Geraets corruptly and explicitly denies that the complainant ever signed this document 5, 6. This recorded denial serves as forensic proof of the clandestine and illicit nature of the operation, proving the document was highly critical to the state-sponsored conspiracy 5, 6, 8.

2. The Consequence: Institutional Capture and Covert Chemical Subjugation

The direct consequence of this fraudulently obtained signature was the creation of a secret Spanish institutional mandate 4, 5. This pseudo-legal extrajudicial curatorship allowed Geraets and his handlers to establish covert directives with Spanish medical personnel, specifically Dra. Carmen Montoya, and local Spanish pharmacies (*Farmacias*) 4, 5.

Exploiting this secret Spanish mandate, the complainant was subjected to severe covert chemical subjugation on Spanish sovereign soil 4, 5. For years, Spanish medical infrastructure was used to secretly administer a powerful, mind-altering antipsychotic medication (Risperdal) to the complainant, fraudulently disguised inside official boxes and blister packs of "baby aspirin 100mg" 4, 5, 9. The intent of this chemical lobotomy was to artificially induce symptoms of psychiatric illness, severely reduce the complainant's high intelligence (IQ 135) to a "zombie" state, and incapacitate his ability to fight the transnational conspiracy 5, 9, 10. This covert poisoning was objectively uncovered on March 24, 2022, when an independent anesthetist at Hospital Marina Baixa confirmed that the hospital's digital system registered the "aspirin" as an antipsychotic 4, 5.

3. Legal Significance for UNCAT Proceedings against Spain

Annex 5 provides critical forensic evidence implicating the Kingdom of Spain in the active facilitation of transnational state capture. Its legal significance for the UNCAT Commission includes:

A. Direct Violation of UNCAT Article 16 (Complicity in Cruel, Inhuman, or Degrading Treatment) By blindly accepting a signature procured under fraudulent pretenses by a foreign operative as a valid medical mandate, the Spanish medical system effectively placed a resident alien under a secret extrajudicial curatorship 11, 12. The execution of this mandate by Spanish doctors and pharmacies—specifically, the covert administration of mind-altering antipsychotics to a healthy individual to deliberately impair his cognitive functions—constitutes an extreme form of cruel, inhuman, and degrading treatment (CIDT) 11, 12. Spain's healthcare infrastructure was actively weaponized, making the state a direct facilitator of psychological and physical destruction 11, 12.

B. Direct Violation of UNCAT Article 12 (Failure to Investigate) Under Article 12, Spain has a mandatory duty to conduct a prompt and impartial investigation whenever there are reasonable grounds to believe torture

or CIDT has occurred in its territory 11, 13. Despite the objective medical discovery of the disguised antipsychotics at Hospital Marina Baixa in 2022, and despite the existence of the audio recording proving Geraets's deception, Spanish authorities failed to initiate any criminal or medical malpractice investigations into the foreign operatives or the complicit Spanish pharmacies 5, 12, 13.

C. Establishing the "Futility Exception" for Exhaustion of Domestic Remedies (Article 22(5)(b)) Annex 5 provides undeniable proof of the "futility exception" regarding the exhaustion of domestic remedies within Spain 14-16. Because the Spanish document signed on January 29, 2016, was physically confiscated by Geraets, and because Spanish medical professionals continuously refuse to provide copies of the subsequent directives that authorized the antipsychotics, the complainant has been structurally stripped of the fundamental documentary evidence required to initiate a domestic medical malpractice or criminal claim in Spanish courts 15, 16. It is mathematically impossible to exhaust domestic judicial remedies when the state and its allied operatives actively steal and conceal the foundational legal documents required to file a suit 15, 16.

Conclusion Annex 5 is forensic proof that the Kingdom of Spain allowed its sovereign medical and legal infrastructure to be captured by a foreign intelligence operation. By validating a deceptive mandate and facilitating covert chemical subjugation, while subsequently withholding the documents necessary for domestic legal defense, Spain actively breached its obligations under the Convention Against Torture and triggered the futility exception for immediate international intervention.
