

ANNEX 9 - Comprehensive Trauma Summary (Justification for Urgent Interim Measures under Rule 114)

RESPONDENT STATE PARTY: The Kingdom of Spain **NATURE OF DOCUMENT:** Clinical and Forensic Trauma Summary, Documentation of Irreparable Harm, and Request for Interim Protection **SUBMISSION FOR:** UNCAT Individual Communication

1. Factual Background: The Psychological and Physical Toll

Annex 9 serves as a comprehensive medical, psychological, and forensic evaluation of the profound trauma inflicted upon the complainant, Ing. Hans Smedema, over a five-decade period 1, 2. This document details the catastrophic human cost of transnational state capture, providing the clinical framework necessary to understand his current vulnerability as a resident alien living in forced exile in Spain 3, 4.

The summary establishes that the complainant is suffering from severe **Complex Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (C-PTSD)** and **Betrayal Trauma**, which are predictable, well-documented clinical responses to chronic, inescapable, and interpersonal trauma orchestrated by trusted state institutions and family members 5, 6. The document forensically outlines the sources of this trauma, which include:

- **Physical Mutilation and Chemical Warfare:** The unconsented forced sterilization in 1972 and the decades-long covert administration of mind-altering substances, including Ketamine and potent antipsychotics (Risperdal) disguised as "baby aspirin" 3, 7.
- **Extraterritorial Electroshock Torture:** Clandestine, high-voltage electroshock sessions conducted on Spanish sovereign soil (Catral in 2008, Benidorm in 2010, Murla in 2011) designed to induce amnesia, "learned helplessness," and submissive conditioning 8, 9.
- **Institutional Gaslighting:** The systematic weaponization of psychiatry by state actors to deliberately label the complainant as "delusional" in order to orchestrate his "civil death," discredit his testimony, and deny him access to domestic legal remedies 5, 7, 10.

2. The Ongoing Threat on Spanish Soil

Crucially for the complaint against Spain, Annex 9 demonstrates that the trauma and danger are not purely historical or confined to the Netherlands; they constitute a continuous, active threat within Spanish jurisdiction 4, 9.

Because the Kingdom of Spain has allegedly accepted fraudulent Dutch psychiatric files and allowed secret institutional mandates to dictate the complainant's care, the Spanish medical and administrative infrastructure has become an instrument of his ongoing persecution 9, 11. The complainant remains at imminent risk of covert chemical subjugation by Spanish pharmacies and doctors, as objectively proven by the March 24, 2022, discovery at Hospital Marina Baixa 9. Furthermore, incidents like the October 2025 "Marcel incident" in Albir—where an operative impersonating a witness's spouse successfully infiltrated a meeting to destroy digital evidence—prove that he remains under active, hostile surveillance by foreign operatives operating with impunity in Spain 4, 12.

3. Legal Significance: Justification for Urgent Interim Measures (Rule 114)

The primary legal function of Annex 9 is to fulfill the strict requirements of **Rule 114 of the UNCAT Rules of Procedure**, which allows the Committee to request that a State Party take interim measures to prevent "irreparable harm" to the victim while the communication is under consideration 4.

Annex 9 proves that without immediate international intervention, the complainant faces an acute and imminent risk of irreversible physical and psychological destruction, justified by the following factors:

- **Advanced Age and Extreme Vulnerability:** The complainant is a 77-year-old victim of torture living in forced exile 4, 13. The financial sabotage he has endured has left him in a precarious financial situation with immense debt, severely limiting his ability to protect himself 14.
- **Neurological Risk of Continued Poisoning:** The *Dossier Médico y de Trauma* warns that administering antipsychotics to an elderly patient with a history of Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) from

high-voltage electroshocks poses a severe, life-threatening neurological risk, actively impeding brain recovery and causing accelerated cognitive decline 15.

Requested Interim Measures Directed at the Kingdom of Spain:Based on the trauma summary, Annex 9 formally demands that the UNCAT Committee compel the Kingdom of Spain to implement the following emergency protections:

1. **Cessation of Harm and Chemical Subjugation:** Spain must proactively shield the complainant from further transnational harassment and explicitly halt any ongoing covert medical/chemical subjugation on its territory 4.
2. **Enforcement of Medical Contraindication Injunction:** Spain must be ordered to issue a binding, system-wide medical injunction across its national health infrastructure (including all local *Farmacias* and hospitals) enforcing an absolute contraindication against the prescription or covert dispensation of antipsychotic medication to the complainant, thereby rejecting the weaponized Dutch psychiatric files 16.
3. **Invalidation of Secret Mandates:** Spain must immediately freeze and declare legally void any secret institutional mandates or guardianship orders derived from the fraudulently obtained 2016 Spanish documents 4.
4. **Facilitation of Independent Forensic Evaluation:** To comply with Article 12 investigative duties, Spain must mandate and fund an independent forensic medical evaluation of the complainant under the UN Istanbul Protocol. To ensure impartiality, this must be conducted outside the compromised Valencian Community, specifically by the **Basque Institute of Legal Medicine** (or affiliated experts of the Basque Istanbul Protocol Project Network), utilizing the Torturing Environment Scale (TES 2.0) 4.

ConclusionAnnex 9 is the critical medical and forensic bridge that elevates the complaint from a historical grievance to an active humanitarian emergency. It proves to the UNCAT Committee that the complainant is suffering from profound, state-engineered C-PTSD and remains in acute, life-threatening danger on Spanish soil, thereby satisfying the threshold for the immediate issuance of protective Interim Measures under Rule 114.
